
Problem Solving Week:

Thank you to our Maths Subject Leader Miss Lally for planning such a fun, challenging and collaborative problem solving week for the whole school.



Anti-Bullying Focus next week:

On 13th-17th November 2023, it is anti-bullying week across the country with the theme **'Make A Noise About Bullying'**. Anti-bullying week signifies a time to come together to have discussions about bullying, how 'banter' can become more hurtful and how we can come together to stop bullying. We have a range of activities, assemblies and lessons organised across the school. Some of those are listed below:

Monday - Odd Socks Day! The week kicks off with Odd Socks Day, highlighting that there is no pressure to wear the latest fashion or expensive items. We encourage all children (and staff) to wear odd socks to school on Monday. The brighter the better!

Thursday - we have a guest speaker from BASE (Body and Soul Education) to talk with the children about the effects of bullying and how we can work together to stamp out any bullying behaviour.
