Classification: There are 3 classes: Class A incorporates those athletes with good balance & recovery and full trunk movement. Class B those with poor balance & recovery but who have full use of one or both upper limbs. Class C athletes with severe physical impairment in all four limbs." Mia 5AM

"Wheelchair Rugby:

Individual players of the game are assigned a classification which reflects the degree of impairment: teams have a point limit, meaning that they have to be made up of players with a variety of classifications in order to qualify for a match."

"Paralympics Para-cycling:

Significant Cyclists: Tristan Bangma is one to watch as he has won 4 world medals and 2 Paralympic medals. Another winner is Fabrizio C; he won 2 world medals but no Paralympic medals yet.
